Preparation

As this game show starts with an audience round you will not need to pre select the contestants.

Each team will need to be provided with a quiz answer sheet and a pen, and each team will need to have an idea of the person who will take part in the rounds if they where to win.

Format

This game show will work in a series of rounds, each round having a classic game show as its theme.

Round One – Telly Addicts

This fast paced round will be used to find the contestants for the game show, 4 couples in total.

The round will be a quick 10 question quiz, all of famous TV themes and images. Once all of the questions have been asked and the answers have been given, we then need to find our 4 highest scoring teams, and get each team to nominate 2 people from their team to take part in the “The Golden Game Show Classics!”

5. What is the name of the Channel 4 show where dinner guests judge the host? **“Come Dine With Me”.**

6. Who did Emily Bishop take in as a lodger in November 1983?

Curly Watts.

7. In EastEnders who spent four months in jail after a road accident on Christmas Eve 1992?

Pat Butcher.

8. Bradley Walsh presents which daytime quiz show on ITV?

Round Two – Blankety Blank

Once you have all 4 couples up on the stage introduce them and find out who they are and where they are from. Then explain the next round which is Blankety Blank and also set the stage with 4 stools, the ladies sat on the stools and the gentlemen stood next to them or behind them.

All 4 couples play this round, and at the end one couple will be eliminated. You should also add an extra element to this round by having Blankety Blank Panelists. This panel should be made up from other members of the entertainments team and members of staff. You will need a panel of 6 panelists.

Your 4 couples will need to be on one side of the stage and the panelists on the other. You will need to split the 4 couples into 2 sets of 2, and each set of 2 will be asked 2 questions alternately.

Question 1 will be asked to couples 1 and 2 – each couple should write down an answer on their pad and so should the panel. We will then reveal the answers given by the contestants and see if it matches any of the panel's answers.

The 3 Couples that have the most points after 2 questions each, will go through to the next round.

Blankety Blank Questions

Question One – Asked to Couples 1 & 2

Popeye said, "When my muscles are aching, I know just how to relax them. I rub Blank all over my body."

Question Two – Asked to Couples 3 & 4

"One of our team members _____' has a terrible head for heights. Last week she even went dizzy standing on the Blank."

Question One – Asked to Couples 1 & 2

"Our Duo member _____ is a little hard of hearing... the other day I asked him to tinkle on the ivories and he started to Blank instead."

Question Two – Asked to Couples 3 & 4

"_____ was at the "World Pancake Making Championship" they had the whisk, the milk, flour and eggs, now all they needed was a Blank "

Round Three – Mr & Mrs

All 3 couples will be asked some classic Mr & Mrs questions, the team with the least correct and matching answers will be eliminated and will leave us with the 2 finalist couples.

This round is where we can spend a little more time, as the other two rounds should have been quite fast paced.

- Start with the Men
- Escort the ladies away to an area where they cannot hear the answers being given.
- You then ask the men the first two questions.
- Welcome back the Ladies and they have to answer the same two questions.
- If the answers match they will win the points
